

# STATEMENT FOR SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS org. 922 114 137

#### **Explanation**

SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS has committed us to conduct our business in accordance with the UN's guiding principles for business and human rights. We respect all internationally recognized human rights, including those enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the UN Convention on Civil and Political Rights, the UN Convention on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Labor Organization's (ILO), Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights in working life and current standards within international humanitarian law.

This report is based on due diligence assessments carried out in the period from June 30, 2023, to May 23, 2024. Our aim with this work is to ensure a transparent, ethical, and sustainable supply chain. By evaluating our suppliers based on the OECD guidelines, we seek to identify and mitigate potential risks related to human rights, employment practices, environmental impact. This comprehensive approach helps us uphold our commitment to high ethical standards and fosters trust and accountability throughout our supply chain and following the law transparency act (åpenhetsloven).

#### General information

SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS is organized with head office in Norway. SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS is a supplier of construction and infrastructure, which are offered to customers in the business market in Norway

Our operations are covered by the Transparency Act and we therefore regularly carry out due diligence assessments by surveying human rights and working conditions in our value chain, including suppliers and other business partners.

By mapping the value chain, it will give us an overview of whether there is or is a risk that human rights violations or indecent working conditions may occur. By carrying out due diligence assessments, we can stop, prevent or limit negative consequences that can be linked directly or indirectly to our business. The work on the due diligence assessments was approved 14.06.2024, and it is the board of SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS that is responsible for ensuring that the business complies with the current requirements of the Transparency Act.

This report consists of an assessment of our own operations and our value chain. All our suppliers are obliged to answer our questions in connection with the survey, and all our suppliers must sign a cooperation agreement and approve our ethical guidelines. If our suppliers do not comply with our ethical guidelines, SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS must follow up with the supplier, if no improvements occur, SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS can terminate cooperation with the supplier.



# Other measures:

### Our mapping

In our work with due diligence assessment, we have adopted Transparency Gate. Via this solution, individuals can request information about our products/services and suppliers. This is called information requirements.

We carry out assessments of all our suppliers one time in the year. Based on your feedback, we can uncover risks and set up measures to reduce risks or remove negative consequences. The measures are followed up, to see if suppliers meet our requirements. SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS has the option to terminate all cooperation with suppliers who do not comply with our requirements. Via this solution, all our suppliers and partners can also respond to our survey

#### Information requirements

Anyone can request information about our business and value chain. People can request information anonymously or by name, and everyone must receive feedback within 21 days. Anyone can report conditions that contravene human rights and decent working conditions, and we will investigate reports that come in to see if any violations have occurred. In our ongoing efforts to map risks, we have identified and evaluated 17 suppliers and partners. However, only 8 of them have responded to the questionnaire we sent via TransparencyGate. Improving this response rate will be a key focus for next year's assessment.

The report below provides detailed insights into the risks associated with each supplier. Additionally, we have gathered information on potential negative consequences, which is illustrated in the accompanying image showing the distribution and scale of these risks.

We are committed to increasing engagement and compliance among our suppliers to ensure a thorough and accurate risk assessment. By doing so, we aim to enhance our overall supply chain transparency and mitigate potential risks more effectively.




## Our findings

## Locations of Our Suppliers and Their Facilities:

We have collected data from 8 out of our 17 suppliers regarding their base locations and the locations of their facilities. Understanding where our suppliers are based and where their operations are located is crucial for our risk assessment and due diligence processes. This information helps us to evaluate potential risks and ensure compliance with our standards across different regions. It also allows us to better understand the geographical distribution of our supply chain and address any region-specific challenges that may arise.

Six of the suppliers purchase from Norway. Additionally, SUBMET ENTREPRENØR AS has a supplier that buys from Romania. Look at the risk report from TransparencyGate below.

In our assessment of supplier locations, we have identified the countries where our suppliers operate. Here is a breakdown of our findings:

- Norway: 6 suppliers
  - Six of our suppliers are based in Norway, indicating a significant portion of our supply chain operates within the country. This domestic presence allows for closer monitoring and potentially lower logistical risks.
- Belgium: 1 supplier
  - One supplier is based in Belgium, contributing to our supply chain diversity within the European Union.
- Denmark: 2 suppliers
  - Two suppliers operate in Denmark, which enhances our network within Scandinavia.
- France: 1 supplier
  - One supplier is located in France, adding to our Western European connections.
- Germany: 2 suppliers
  - o Two suppliers are based in Germany, a key industrial hub in Europe.
- Italy: 2 suppliers
  - Two suppliers are from Italy
- Liechtenstein: 1 supplier
  - One supplier is from Liechtenstein, a unique addition due to the country's strong financial and regulatory framework.
- Sweden: 2 suppliers
  - Two suppliers operate in Sweden, further supporting our Scandinavian supply chain network.
- Switzerland: 1 supplier
  - One supplier is based in Switzerland, known for its high-quality standards and robust economic environment.
- Taiwan: 1 supplier
  - o One supplier operates in Taiwan
- Austria: 1 supplier
  - One supplier is based in Austria, adding to our Central European supply chain.
- Finland: 1 supplier
  - o One supplier is from Finland
- Romania: 1 supplier
  - One supplier is based in Romania.
- United Kingdom: 1 supplier
  - One supplier operates in the United Kingdom
- United States: 1 supplier
  - One supplier is based in the United States



**Conclusion:** Our suppliers are well-distributed across several key regions, with a significant concentration in Norway and a balanced presence in other European countries,

In our ongoing effort to ensure a responsible and ethical supply chain, we have conducted a detailed analysis of our suppliers. Here is an excerpt from our findings, focusing on Supplier 1 and 6:

#### Supplier 1:

• Total Score: 4.86

• Total Due Diligence: 100%

This supplier's commitment to ethical practices is evident in their comprehensive approach to human rights, employment, environmental sustainability, anti-bribery measures, consumer interests, and tax and competition policies.
- Human Rights: 4.53 Supplier 1 has shown a strong commitment to protecting human rights, scoring 4.53 in this category. Their policies and practices ensure fair treatment and respect for all individuals involved in their operations.



- **Employment**: 4.58 With a score of 4.58, Supplier 1 excels in employment standards, providing a safe and equitable work environment for their employees.
- Environment & Climate: 5 Achieving a perfect score in Environment & Climate,
   Supplier 1 has implemented robust measures to minimize their environmental impact and promote sustainability.
- Combat Bribery: 4.92 Scoring 4.92 in combating bribery, Supplier 1 has strong anticorruption policies and practices in place, ensuring integrity in all their dealings.
- Consumer Interests: 5 Supplier 1 prioritizes consumer interests, reflected in their perfect score in this category. They are committed to delivering products and services that meet high standards of quality and safety.

- **Employment**: 5 With a perfect score of 5 in employment, Supplier 6 excels in providing a safe and equitable work environment for their employees.
- Environment & Climate: 5 Achieving a perfect score in Environment & Climate, Supplier 6 has implemented robust measures to minimize their environmental impact and promote sustainability.
- Combat Bribery: 4.92 Scoring 4.92 in combating bribery, Supplier 6 has strong anticorruption policies and practices in place, ensuring integrity in all their dealings.

One of our suppliers (Supplier 5 on the sheet) received a low score in the Environment & Climate category. After investigating, we found that this supplier does not produce physical goods, which explains why they have no significant impact on the climate.

The supplier with the highest risk according to the TransparencyGate score is Supplier 7, with a total score of 8.53. In response to the question, "Where is your company based and where are your production facilities located?" they listed Austria, Denmark, Finland, Germany, Italy, Norway, Romania, Sweden, the United Kingdom, and the United States. This indicator measures gender equality in the workplace, specifically focusing on the proportion of women in the total labor force aged 15 and older who are engaged in paid employment. It thereby provides insights into the extent of women's participation in the formal workforce.

#### Our measures

- Measures taken: We have made an effort to map every supplier in our value chain. So far, eight of the suppliers have completed our questionnaire based on OECD guidelines. We've discovered that one supplier's value chain has a location in Romania. However, most of our suppliers are based in Norway. We do not view this as a significant risk factor since they do not buy or sell physical goods from Romania.
- Planned measures: Out of 17 suppliers, eight have responded to the questionnaire.
   We will follow up with those who have not yet responded. Additionally, we will focus on suppliers with a Due Diligence Score below 50%, ensuring they meet our standards.
- Result of measures: All of our suppliers have a risk score above 9 according to the TransparencyGate Score. Among them, six suppliers have achieved a Due Diligence Score over 90%, demonstrating strong compliance with our standards. However, two suppliers have a Due Diligence Score below 50%, indicating areas that need significant improvement. We will prioritize follow-up actions with these lower-scoring suppliers to ensure they meet our compliance expectations.
- As a minimum: Our goal is to have 70% of our suppliers complete our
  questionnaire. This will help us ensure that the majority of our supply chain aligns
  with our standards and guidelines. By gathering this information, we can better
  assess and improve our overall compliance and risk management. We believe that
  achieving this target will significantly enhance our understanding of our suppliers'
  practices and commitment to our shared values.
